Impact and Outcome

Assist adults wanting to improve their basic literacy skills so they can achieve their goals, increase their knowledge and develop their potential.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide one-on-one tutoring to an adult in basic reading, writing, spelling or math.
- Submit simple monthly reports on hours tutored, progress and challenges.
- Maintain contact with Literacy Services Center regarding student needs, concerns, questions, etc.

Qualifications

- Must be over the age of 18
- Flexible, mature and patient
- Interest in and ability to work with people from diverse backgrounds

<u>Commitment</u>

Minimum six months commitment. Schedule determined by tutor and student; typically two hours per week plus an hour of preparation, reporting and travel time.
