Purpose of Position:	Provide one-to-one or small group tutoring for adults, 18 years of age and older in speaking English, reading, writing and/or math skills.
Qualifications:	Eighteen years of age and older. High school diploma or GED, high school equivalency diploma Caring and culturally sensitive attitude Flexible and patient Completion of 15-hour tutor training, or other adult education certification Dependable and able to keep a two-day per week commitment for a minimum of six months, but preferably one year.
<b>Responsible To:</b>	Literacy Tutor/Learner Coordinators
<b>Responsibilities:</b>	<ol> <li>Complete 15-hour volunteer tutor training workshop.</li> <li>Attend regularly schedule in-service tutor training workshops, tutor support group meetings and READ/San Diego's annual tutor conference.</li> <li>Maintain a portfolio of student work, lesson plans, progress tests and attendance records.</li> <li>Demonstrate competency in teaching basic literacy skills.</li> <li>Evaluate learner progress.</li> <li>Complete tutor monthly report by the third of the month and other record-keeping forms as necessary.</li> <li>Ensure accountability (attendance, performance, reporting.)</li> </ol>
Training Provided:	Fifteen hours of pre-service tutor training to teach basic literacy skills to English language adult learners or English as a Second Language adult learners; ongoing in-service training (two trainings required every six months) at tutor support group meetings, regularly scheduled in-service trainings, and READ/San Diego's annual tutor conference.
Benefits of Volunteering:	Recognition given at the Annual Volunteer Recognition Luncheon, other recognition events, and in READ/San Diego publications; the personal rewards of helping others; job experience; and entitlement to the City of San Diego's volunteer package.
Time Commitment:	Minimum of two 1.5-hour tutoring sessions per week; one hour planning per week; or minimum of four hours per week.
Length of Commitment:	Minimum of six months to one year or more.
