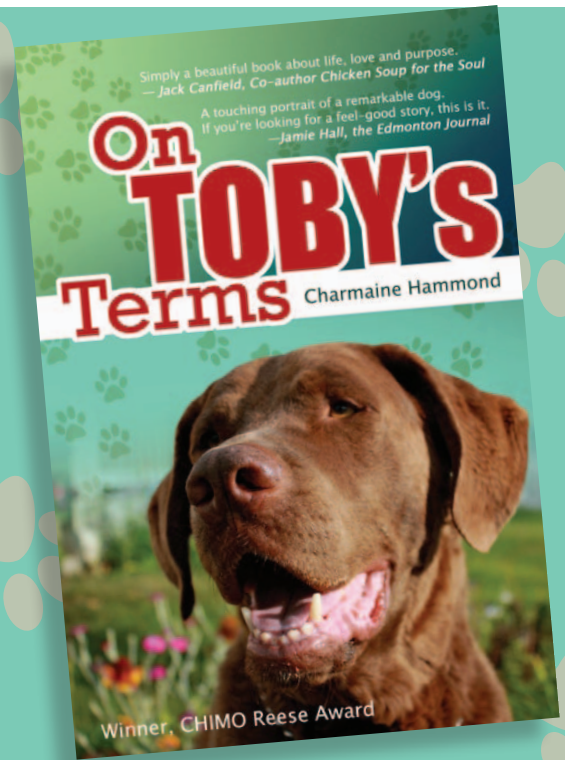

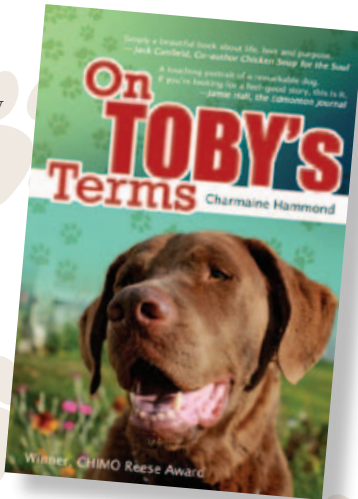

## On Toby's Terms

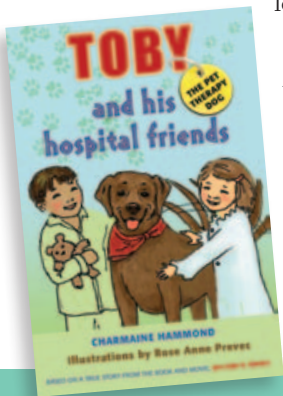
