Responsibilities:

- Assist with taking raw photos and recording videos for social media.
- Assist with prep and set-up for photo/video shoots as needed (i.e., setting up props for flatlays, pulling specific-subject books, etc.)
- Assist with editing and processing final photos/videos to post to social media.

- Learn about the different types of careers available within a Public Library
- Gain professional experience

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in an internship course where credit is awarded for hours completed
- Comfortable with photo/video functions of a smartphone either Android or iPhone.
- Has experience using social media platforms such as Instagram and Pinterest, personally or professionally and other similar apps such as SnapChat.
- Experience using different photo-video editing apps such as Snapseed, built-in filters, color adjustments, etc.
- Can provide samples of photos taken in a portfolio.
- Good communication skills, patience, and enthusiasm working with others
- Be willing and able to follow directions
- Ability to commit to and keep scheduled hours
 - Schedules to be determined by social media committee and Intern

Application Procedure:

- Submit an Orange Public Library Volunteer Application
- Interview with Library staff
- Background process, which may include fingerprinting and/or drug screening. This process is paid for by the City of Orange
